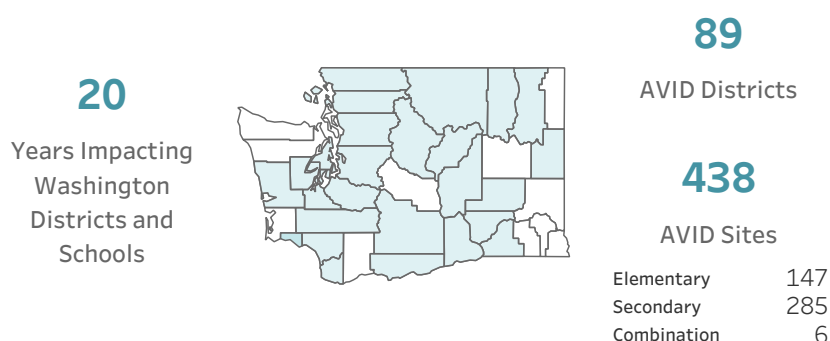




Washington Snapshot

Accelerate underachieving students who have potential into more rigorous courses.

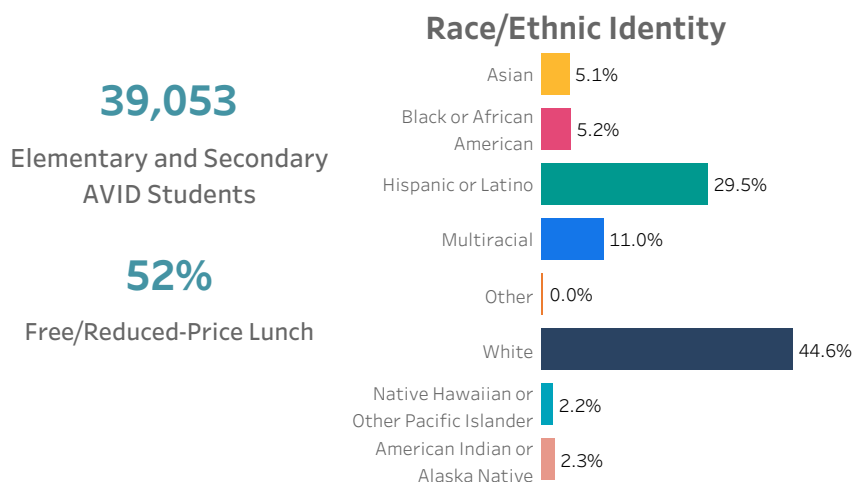
Teach academic and social skills not targeted in other classes.
